

ORDINANCE NO. 042616-1

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 051314-1  
OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES, CITY OF AKRON, IOWA  
CONCERNING WATER AND SEWER RATE CHARGES  
WITHIN THE CITY OF AKRON, IOWA

WHEREAS, notice of a public hearing on a proposed 2016 Rate Adjustment to the City of Akron, Iowa Municipal Water and Sewer Utility Rates has been duly given in compliance with the Code of Iowa, and;

WHEREAS, a public hearing has been held on the 26<sup>th</sup> day of April, 2016 at 7:00 p.m. at the Akron City Hall on the proposed 2016 Rate Adjustment to the City of Akron, Iowa Municipal Water and Sewer Utility Rates at the time and place as specified in said notice and all objections or other comments relating to the proposed rate change have been heard,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AKRON, IOWA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the following new electric, water and sewer rates are hereby established for users of the Akron Municipal Utilities:

WATER

First 1,000 gallons	\$7.56 per 1,000
Next 4,000 gallons	\$3.08 per 1,000
Next 5,000 gallons	\$2.52 per 1,000
Next 10,000 gallons	\$2.11 per 1,000

SEWER

Residential	0 – 3,000 gallons	\$13.04 per month
	3,001 – 10,000 gallons	\$0.66 per 1,000
	Over 10,000 gallons	\$0.00 no extra charge
Commercial	0 – 20,000 gallons	\$18.26 per month
	20,001 – 60,000 gallons	\$26.68 per month
	Over 60,000 gallons	\$61.28 per month

Section 2. Effective Date of Rate Change. The rates set forth in this Ordinance shall be put into effect following the final passage, approval and publication of this Ordinance and shall begin being charged on May 26, 2016 with the first meter reading to take place on June 27, 2016.

Section 3. Conflicting Ordinances Repealed. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed.

Section 4. Severability Clause. If any section, provision, or part of this Ordinance shall be adjudged invalid or unconstitutional, such adjudication shall not affect the validity of the Ordinance as a whole or any section, provision, or part thereof not adjudged invalid or unconstitutional.

Section 5. Effective Date of Ordinance. This Ordinance shall be in effect after its final passage, approval and publication as provided by law.
