

ORDINANCE NO. 072616-1

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 042616-1
OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES, CITY OF AKRON, IOWA
AND CORRECTING SEWER RATE CHARGES
WITHIN THE CITY OF AKRON, IOWA

WHEREAS, notice of a public hearing on a proposed correction to the 2016 Rate Adjustment to the City of Akron, Iowa Sewer Rates has been duly given in compliance with the Code of Iowa, and;

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Akron, Iowa previously addressed by Ordinance a 2016 rate adjustment to the City's Water, Sewer and Garbage Rates and adopted Ordinance 042616-1; and

WHEREAS, the City Council noticed that the final version of Ordinance 042616-1 published for record contained a scrivener's error in the sewer rate to be charged commercial customers for usage of 20,001 to 60,000 gallons. Such rate being published as \$26.68, when the intended rate to be adopted was \$28.68; and

WHEREAS, a public hearing has been held on the 12th day of July, 2016 at 7:00 p.m. at the Akron City Hall on the proposed correction to the 2016 Rate Adjustment to the City of Akron, Iowa Sewer Rates at the time and place as specified in said notice and all objections or other comments relating to the proposed corrected rate change have been heard,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AKRON, IOWA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the following corrected sewer rate is hereby established for users of the Akron Municipal Utilities:

SEWER

Commercial	20,001 – 60,000 gallons	\$28.68 per month
------------	-------------------------	-------------------

Section 2. Effective Date of Rate Change. The rates set forth in this Ordinance shall be put into effect following the final passage, approval and publication of this Ordinance and shall begin being charged on August 26, 2016 with the first meter reading to take place on September 27, 2016.

Section 3. Conflicting Ordinances Repealed. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed.

Section 4. Severability Clause. If any section, provision, or part of this Ordinance shall be adjudged invalid or unconstitutional, such adjudication shall not affect the validity of the Ordinance as a whole or any section, provision, or part thereof not adjudged invalid or unconstitutional.

Section 5. Effective Date of Ordinance. This Ordinance shall be in effect after its final passage, approval and publication as provided by law.


